PUBLIC HEALTH (COVID-19 EMERGENCY POWERS) (NO. 3) AMENDMENT  
REGULATIONS 2020

His Excellency the Governor, on the advice of the Minister of Health, and in exercise of the power conferred by section 107B of the Public Health Act 1949, makes the following Regulations:

Citation

1 These Regulations, which amend the Public Health (COVID-19 Emergency Powers) (No. 3) Regulations 2020 (“the principal Regulations”), may be cited as the Public Health (COVID-19 Emergency Powers) (No. 3) Amendment Regulations 2020.

Amends regulation 2

2 In regulation 2 of the principal Regulations, in the definition of “enforcement officer”—

- (a) at the end of paragraph (a), delete “or”;
- (b) at the end of paragraph (b), insert “or”; and
- (c) insert after paragraph (b)—

“(c) a customs officer;”.

Amends regulation 4

3 In paragraphs (1), (2), (3)(d) and (4) of regulation 4 of the principal Regulations, delete “75” and substitute “50”.

Amends regulation 5

4 In regulation 5(4) of the principal Regulations, delete “superintendent” and substitute “inspector”.

Amends regulation 6

5 In regulation 6 of the principal Regulations, insert after paragraph (1)—

“(1A) Further guidance regarding other precautions to be taken, referred to in paragraph (1), may include guidance requiring the testing for COVID-19 of the staff of a business or facility, or of any category of business or facility.”.

Amends regulation 8

6 In regulation 8(2) of the principal Regulations, delete “75” and substitute “50”.

Amends regulation 9

7 In regulation 9 of the principal Regulations, insert after paragraph (1)—

“(1A) A person who fails to take all reasonable steps, as required by regulation 3, to maintain appropriate physical distancing by not wearing a mask when one is required commits an offence and is liable on summary conviction to—

(a) a fine of \$500, in respect of a first offence;

(b) a fine of \$1,000, for a second or subsequent offence.”.
