PUBLIC HEALTH (COVID-19 EMERGENCY POWERS) AMENDMENT (NO. 2)
REGULATIONS 2021

Her Excellency the Governor, on the advice of the Minister responsible for health, and in exercise of the power conferred by section 107B of the Public Health Act 1949, makes the following Regulations:

Citation

1 These Regulations, which amend the Public Health (COVID-19 Emergency Powers) Regulations 2021 (“the principal Regulations”), may be cited as the Public Health (COVID-19 Emergency Powers) Amendment (No. 2) Regulations 2021.

Amends regulation 5

2 In regulation 5 of the principal Regulations—

- (a) in paragraph (3)(c), delete “20 per cent” and substitute “25 per cent”;
- (b) after paragraph (3)(c), insert—

“(ca) persons while in attendance at—

- (i) an outdoor religious service or ceremony;
- (ii) an outdoor funeral service;
- (iii) an outdoor marriage ceremony;
- (iv) an outdoor domestic partnership ceremony;

but the number of persons at the outdoor service or ceremony shall not exceed 50;”;

- (c) in paragraph (4), delete “(3)(c)” and substitute “(3)(c) and (ca)”.

Amends regulation 6

3 In regulation 6(2)(c) of the principal Regulations, delete “six persons” and substitute “ten persons”.

Amends regulation 7

4 In regulation 7(1)(b) of the principal Regulations, delete “six persons” and substitute “ten persons”.

Amends regulation 10

5 In regulation 10 of the principal Regulations, delete “6pm” and substitute “8pm”.
