

ROAD TRAFFIC ACT 1947

ROAD TRAFFIC (MOHAWK GRAND PRIX BICYCLE, GO KART AND MOTOR GO KART ROAD RACE) (VARIATION OF SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 2026

In exercise of the power conferred upon the Minister responsible for works and engineering by section 7(2A) of the Road Traffic Act 1947, the following Order is hereby made:

1. This Order may be cited as the Road Traffic (Mohawk Grand Prix Bicycle, Go Kart and Motor Go Kart Road Race) (Variation of Speed Limits) Order 2026.
2. This Order applies to the contestants and to the attendant vehicles to the contestants of the Mohawk Grand Prix Bicycle, Go Kart and Motor Go Kart Road Race to be held on Friday, 3rd April 2026.
3. The speed limits fixed by section 7(2)(a) of the Road Traffic Act 1947 are hereby varied to the extent specified in the first column of the Schedule in respect of the contestants and the attendant vehicles to the contestants of the Mohawk Grand Prix Bicycle, Go Kart and Motor Go Kart Road Race.
4. The roads or parts thereof specified in the second column of the Schedule are hereby declared to be subject, at the times specified in the third column of the Schedule, in respect of the contestants and the attendant vehicles to the contestants of the Mohawk Grand Prix Bicycle, Go Kart and Motor Go Kart Road Race, to the speed limit specified in the first column thereof.

SCHEDULE

SPEED LIMIT	ROADS	TIMES
50 kilometres per hour	Bicycle participants, Go Kart participants and Motor Go Kart participants will commence on Mount Road, at the St. David's Lighthouse near the turnaround area, then travel in a northerly direction to St. Luke's Lane, turn left onto St. Luke's Lane then travel in a westerly direction towards Texas Road, then turn right onto Texas Road and travel in a north easterly direction towards Great Bay Road, then turn right onto Great Bay Road, then travel in an easterly direction along Great Bay Road to the St. David's Cricket Club entrance and end the race.	4:00pm to 5:30pm
