MERCHANT SHIPPING (PROVISIONS, CATERING AND SHIP'S COOKS) AMENDMENT REGULATIONS 2024

BR 30 / 2024

The Minister responsible for Maritime Administration, in exercise of the power conferred by sections 59 and 93 of the Merchant Shipping Act 2002, makes the following Regulations:

Citation

1 These Regulations may be cited as the Merchant Shipping (Provisions, Catering and Ship's Cooks) Amendment Regulations 2024.

Substitutes regulation 5

2 The Merchant Shipping (Provisions, Catering and Ship's Cooks) Regulations 2013 (the "principal Regulations") are amended by deleting regulation 5 and substituting the following—

"Standards of supplies

5 (1) The food and drinking water supplied, shall, having regard to the number of seafarers on board, their religious requirements and cultural practices as they pertain to food, and the duration and nature of the voyage, be suitable in quantity, nutritional value, quality and variety, and shall be provided free of charge during the period of engagement.

(2) The organisation and equipment of the catering department shall be such as to permit the provision to the seafarers of adequate, varied, balanced and nutritious meals prepared and served in hygienic conditions."

Amends regulation 8

3 Regulation 8(1) of the principal Regulations is amended—

- (a) in subparagraph (c) by deleting “and”;
- (b) in subparagraph (d) by deleting the full stop and substituting “; and”;
and
- (c) by inserting the following subparagraph next after subparagraph (d)—
 - “(e) supply of food and drinking water in relation to its quantity,
nutritional value, quality and variety.”.
