GOVERNMENT FEES AMENDMENT REGULATIONS 1996

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 2(1) of the Government Fees Act 1965, and every other power vested in him, the Minister of Finance makes the following Regulations:—

Citation

1 These Regulations may be cited as the Government Fees Amendment Regulations 1996.

Revocation and replacement of Schedule to S.R.& O. 24/1976

The Schedule to the Government Fees Regulations 1976 is revoked and the Schedule set forth in the Schedule to these Regulations is substituted.

Commencement and transitional

- 3 (1) Subject to paragraph (2), these Regulations commence on 1 April 1996 ("commencement day").
- (2) Nothing in these Regulations affects the validity or effect of a fee that was paid— $\,$
 - (a) before commencement day; and
 - (b) in respect of a period that was still running on that day.
