The Minister, in exercise of the power conferred upon him by section 12 of the Government Employees (Health Insurance) Act 1986, makes the following Order:—

Citation and commencement

1 This Order may be cited as the Government Employees (Health Insurance) (Rates) Order 2001 and shall come into operation on 1 April 2001.

Rates

2 The rates of contribution to be paid by or in respect of an insured person shall be as specified in the Schedule.

Revokes BR25/2000

3 The Government Employees (Health Insurance) (Rates) Order 2000 is revoked.
