The Minister of Finance, in exercise of the power conferred by customs procedure code 4229 of the Fifth Schedule to the Customs Tariff Act 1970, issues the following Notice:

Citation

1 This Notice may be cited as the Customs Tariff (Approved Businesses - CPC 4229) Notice 2019.

Interpretation

2 In this Notice, “customs procedure code” or “CPC” has the meaning given in section 1 of the Customs Tariff Act 1970.
